### cooling pedicures

Battle the heat of summer from the ground up, with some refreshing aromatherapy-based pampering.

#### Iguazú Day Spa

The luxurious Iguazu Falls pedicure (\$58 for 60 minutes) at this sleek, welcoming West Village haven aims to soothe tired, swollen feet with a leisurely eucalyptus-and-mint-infused bath, followed by a bracing marine-mineral blue clay mask. Bonus: The session includes a stress-melting half hour of reflexology.

The tony Midtown salon-spa's hourlong Cooling Deluxe Pedicure (\$80) kicks off as most great nail treatments do, with an extensive soak, exfoliation, and deep leg massage. Then comes the best part: a tingling 15-minute seaweed and mud mask with stimulating camphor, topped off with a gel made from peppermint, eucalyptus, spearmint, and mandarin essential oils, to freshen your entire system.

fresh cucumber and mint bath, followed by a reviving tea-tree-and-citrus-oil nail conditioning and light reflexology.
